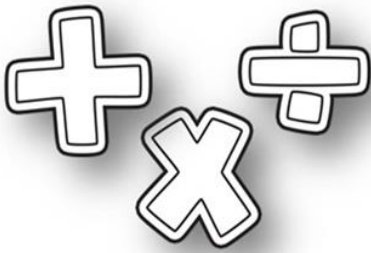

Math with Mrs. Dent:
