### *Homework Reminders:*

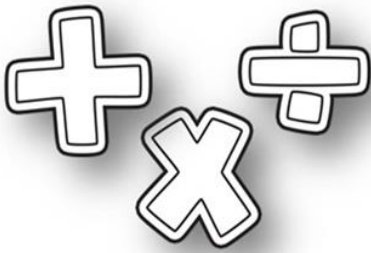
- Continue reading and earning points toward A.R. goals for Quarter 3 (ends March 12)!
